



HORNER APG's STATEMENT OF CONFLICT MINERALS SOURCING

Horner APG is committed to sourcing responsibly and considers mining activities that fuel ongoing conflict and resulting humanitarian disaster in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, or any adjoining country, which is financed in part by trade in the ores from which tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold ("3TG") are derived as unacceptable.

Horner APG efforts related to conflict minerals is aligned to the work of the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition[®] (EICC[®]) and Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI).

Horner APG expects its suppliers to source with reasonable due diligence in dealing with their own supply chain with regards to this matter.

Horner APG will not purchase products that contain conflict minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit the DRC or adjoining countries.

Horner APG understands this issue to its customers and is committed to our efforts that work towards a conflict free Supply chain.
